

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
PAUMA VALLEY COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT
REGARDING THE PLACEMENT OF DELINQUENT CHARGES
ON THE COUNTY TAX ROLL FOR COLLECTION**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the General Manager of the Pauma Valley Community Services District (“District”) has prepared and submitted to the Board of Directors a written report identifying parcels within the District with delinquent charges that remain unpaid and are proposed for collection on the San Diego County property tax roll.

A Public Hearing on the report will be held on Monday, June 22nd, 2026, at 10:00 A.M., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard. The hearing will take place at the Pauma Valley Community Services District, located at 33129 Cole Grade Road, Pauma Valley, CA 92061. Meeting details and agenda will be available at www.paumavalleycsd.ca.gov.

At the hearing, the Board of Directors will hear and consider any objections or protests regarding the proposed placement of delinquent charges on the County tax roll. Following the hearing, the Board may adopt, revise, or modify the report and may authorize the delinquent charges to be submitted to the San Diego County Auditor and placed on the County tax roll for collection in the same manner as property taxes.

Any property owner wishing to object to the proposed charges or the placement of charges on the County tax roll may appear at the hearing and be heard. Written objections may also be submitted to the District office prior to the hearing date.
