

RESOLUTION NO. 135

**A RESOLUTION OF THE PAUMA VALLEY COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT APPROVING
RATE INCREASES FOR SECURITY PATROL AND GATES SERVICES PURSUANT TO
PROPOSITION 26**

WHEREAS, the Pauma Valley Community Services District is a governmental agency duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of California;

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Pauma Valley Community Services District has the authority to set regulatory fees for services provided to the community;

WHEREAS, Proposition 26 requires that certain fees and charges be approved through an open hearing process;

WHEREAS, an open hearing was duly noticed and conducted in accordance with the rules of Proposition 26 to consider rate increases for Security Patrol and Gates services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Directors of the Pauma Valley Community Services District, that:

1. The regulatory fees for Security Patrol will be increased from **\$137.19** to **\$156.69** **January 1st, 2026**, and to **\$169.59** **July 1st, 2026**.
2. The regulatory fees for Security Gates will be increased from **\$121.50** to **\$124.43** **January 1st, 2026**, and to **\$132.41** **July 1st, 2026**.
3. Following the July 1st, 2026 fee increases, the Board may adopt annual fee increases based on budgetary needs; however, increases shall not exceed annual automatic inflationary increases of 6.5% in accordance with Proposition 26 requirements.
4. The Pauma Valley Community Services District staff are directed to take all necessary actions to implement and enforce the approved rate increases.
5. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
